

We remain in the season of Easter, in the period of EASTERTIDE, which concludes after 50 days (7 weeks including Easter Sunday). Then, on May 28th this year, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday(also known as Whitsunday) when the faithful celebrate by wearing red in remembrance of our Lord's death upon the cross, or might also wear white in honor of the babies wearing white at baptismal/ christening ceremonies on this holy Sunday commemorating the day,2000 years ago, when the Holy Spirit descended upon His disciples, and to us.
